

What does a cicada look like? They come in different sizes. In North America, a small Aridland Cicada is about half an inch long. In Asia, an Empress Cicada can be three inches long. Some cicadas are the largest true bugs in the world. Cicadas have four wings that you can see through. They have two red, round eyes, one on each side of their heads. They also have three extra eyes on top of their heads.

Where does a cicada live?

Cicadas live underground for a long time. They come out when the ground a bit below the surface reaches **64 degrees**. Billions of them will soon come out in the eastern part of the United States. That might sound scary. But they won't hurt you. They don't even bite. At least fourteen states will see cicadas all over. This group of cicadas is called **Brood X**. They come out every seventeen years.




What can you do with a cicada besides listen to it? Some people eat them. A man has even written a cookbook with bug recipes. Some people think they taste like peanut butter. Even so,



Cut along the dashes of the bottom pictures.







Cicada Code

Cicadas are an important part of our ecosystem because they provide food for animals. Use the code to discover what some of them are.

Cicadas hatch from eggs, go through metamorphosis, and then finally enter adulthood. When young cicadas hatch, they drop to the soil and hide themselves underground. They survive by sucking juices from the tree roots. A couple years later, they emerge to the surface and climb a tree where they finish the journey to become adults.
